PRIVACY POLICY

At St Albans and Hertfordshire Architectural and Archaeological Society (SAHAAS), we are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. Please be assured that we will NEVER sell your details or share them with anyone outside of SAHAAS. At any time, you can change how you hear from us or unsubscribe from our mailing lists, just let us know.

This policy explains why we collect information from you, what information we need, how we use it and keep it safe.

Why do we collect personal information?

You may give us your personal information in order to sign up for a subscription, make a donation, participate in an event, or sign up for our newsletter. The personal information we collect might include your name, address, email address, telephone number, payment card or bank details. We collect this information only in connection with specific activities, such as subscription, donation processing or sending information about our work.

What your personal information may be used for?

- To fulfil your subscription application
- Process subscriptions, donations or other payments
- Set up or alter your Direct Debit Instruction via BACS
- Ask you to support specific SAHAAS activity by taking part in one of our fundraising events
- Support us financially by donating to one of our appeals
- Confirm details of your Gift Aid status if applicable
- Send you our publications such as our newsletter and annual report

Use of our Website

- You should be aware that if you follow a link to another website and give any personal information to another company, the uses to which that information may be put will be determined by that company's privacy policy.
- Third parties, including Google, Facebook and Twitter, may use cookies, pixels web beacons, and similar technologies to collect or receive information from our website and elsewhere on the internet and use that information to provide audience insights, measurement services and targeted advertisements. This helps us gather data so that we can improve our website and our digital communications. These cookies are anonymous, storing information about content you browse on our site, but not about who you are. Users can opt-out of the collection and use of information for ad targeting using a mechanism for exercising such choice such as aboutads.info/choices or www.youronlinechoices.eu/.

Use of cookies

A "cookie" is a piece of information, like a tag, which some websites create on your PC. Our cookies allocate each user of this website with a random number. This procedure does not entail the collection of any personal information. Our cookies will not be used to analyse your visits to other websites or track any internet searches you may undertake whilst on this website.

What if I don't want to accept cookies?

Your browser lets you choose whether to accept, not to accept or to be warned before accepting cookies. These settings can be found in the advanced preferences.

In Internet Explorer select Tools menu > Internet options> Security > Custom Level
