NOTE.

As this volume goes to press (March, 1927) we learn that, during the rebuilding of St. Michael's Vicarage, four blocks of Roman concrete and a piece of Roman wall have been found by the builder at depths varying from 7 feet 2 inches to 8 feet 9 inches. Mr. A. W. Sharp, of Watson's Walk, has very kindly supplied us with a plan, which will be preserved in the Society's library, showing the position of these fragments.
