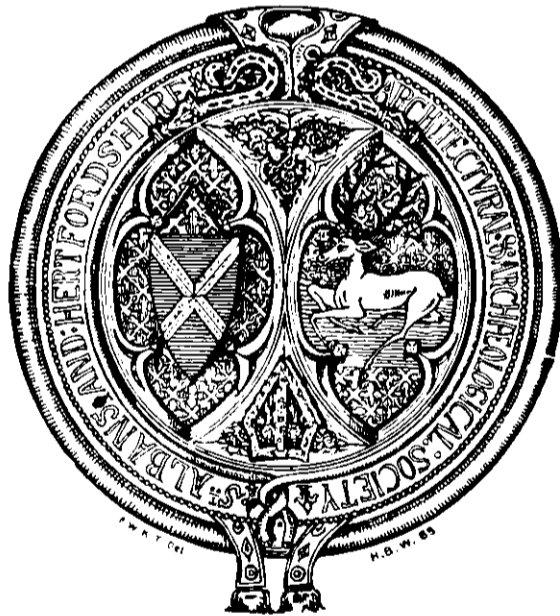

President's Report for the Year 1937

I am pleased to be able to record that this has been a busy and successful year, and that thirty-one new members have been elected since my last report.

It is a cause for much satisfaction that the building of the permanent museum at Verulamium will be begun immediately and that the large and valuable collection of pre-Roman and Roman finds will then become available for inspection and study. The site continues to attract a large number of British and overseas visitors, and the number cannot fail to be increased when the museum has been opened.

We propose, subject to the consent of the City Council being obtained, to place in the Verulamium museum a tablet recording how greatly the success of the excavations was due to the energy and enthusiasm of the late Mrs. Mortimer Wheeler.

The excavation of a Roman villa at Lockleys, Welwyn, carried out by Mr. Ward Perkins, has proved of outstanding interest. An article dealing with the work will be published in our TRANSACTIONS for 1937.

Another important excavation at Rothamsted, Harpenden, has been conducted by three of our members—Mr. James Broad, Mr. Anthony Lowther and Mr. Denis Wilson. This will also be described in our forthcoming TRANSACTIONS.

Lord Brocket has very generously presented to Wheathampstead the Devil's Dyke, an entrenchment which is part of a British city built in the first century B.C., where, probably, Julius Cæsar defeated Cassivellaunus in 51 B.C. We have been pleased to contribute towards the cost of providing a tablet recording the historical importance of the site.

At the instance of the Congress of Archæological Societies we have undertaken to prepare a list of antiquities and other historical monuments in our county. We hope that our members will co-operate by informing the Hon. Secretary of any such antiquities of which they have knowledge.

We have sustained eight losses by death during the year, among them being our oldest member, who joined the Society fifty-five years ago. The names will be found in our obituary notices.
